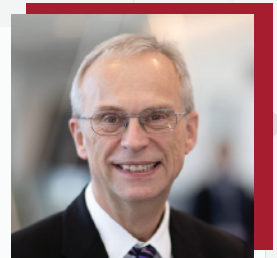
The ICRP System of Radiological Protection

Werner Rühm leads the Medical and Environmental Dosimetry Group at the Helmholtz Center, Munich Institute of Radiation Medicine in Germany. He is also a professor at the Medical Faculty of the University of Munich. He has been a member of Committee 1 "Radiation Effects" (C1) of the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP) since 2005, serving as C1 secretary from 2012 to 2016, and as C1 chair from 2016 to 2021. He currently serves as the chair of the Main Commission.
