David Sutton has a PhD in Medical Physics and until recently was the Head of Medical Physics at Ninewells Hospital, Dundee, having worked in radiation protection and diagnostic radiology physics for over thirty five years. He has now retired from the United Kingdom National Health Service but still holds an honorary chair from the University of Dundee.



David is currently the Chair of ICRP Committee 3, Co-Chair of ICRP Task Group 113 and a member of ICRP Task Group 108. He is presently a member of the UK Committee on Medical Aspects of Radiation in the Environment and is also the current Chair of the Board of the UK accrediting body for Radiation Protection Experts, RPA2000. Education and training have interested him throughout his career and he a former lead for the Scottish Medical Physics and Clinical Engineering Training Scheme. David has served as an expert in radiation protection for the IAEA. He has been a member of the editorial board of the British Journal of Radiology and has served on many national and international committees and has edited, authored or contributed to several textbooks, monographs and other publications, all in the fields of diagnostic radiology physics and radiation protection.

David is a Fellow of the Institute of Physics and Engineering and Medicine, a Fellow of the Society for Radiological Protection and an Honorary Fellow of the British Institute of Radiology.
