Hiroki Fujita received bachelor's and master's in science from the University of Niigata in 1998 and 2000, respectively. In April 2000, he joined the Japan Nuclear Cycle Development Institute (JNC) as a Researcher. The Japan Atomic Energy Agency (JAEA) was established to merge the JNC and the Japan Atomic Energy Research Institute (JAERI) in October 2005.
