## **Resolution of Comments**

The comment sought clarification on the methodology used to interpolate S-coefficients at non-reference ages greater than 1-year old. Although the draft report contained text which attempted to describe this interpolation, an improvement has been made in the revised report to assist the reader in finding the description of the interpolation method.
